

### Main infrastructural work completed and scheduled

**Gesac, the Naples International Airport management company, has been committed to a significant infrastructure development programme for several years.**

Between 1998 and the present, the management company has invested a total of 192 million Euro\*, of which 110 were self-financed, for the development of infrastructure and services. Currently, a series of expansion and optimization works are underway which will result in an even more functional, safe and comfortable airport by 2009.

Following is a brief summary of the infrastructure work at Naples International Airport completed or scheduled

#### **Check-in area:**

- 28 check-in counters (completed December 2008)
- 2 additional conveyor belts for departing baggage (completed June 2007)

#### **Expansion of Departures Concourse:**

- new modern, functional vertical connections (completed July 2009)

#### **Commercial area**

- New Food and beverage area and overall reconfiguration of landside commercial area

#### **Security control units**

- 10 x-ray screening units (completed August 2008)

#### **Boarding Lounge:**

- Extension of passenger boarding lounge (completed July 2007)

#### **Arrivals area:**

Extension of arrivals area

- 5 new baggage conveyor belts new Lost & , First aid centre (completed June 2007)

#### **Aprons:**

- Repaving of runway – completed the 4th, 5th and 6th of June 2007)
- New jet fuel and petrol depot and distributing system
- new airside water drainage system
- 7 new aprons (completed May 2006)

#### **Forecourt**

- New parking area for tourist buses (December 2008)
- New multi-storey parking for passengers

- New external layout (completed July 2009)
